

Speech Language Pathology

How we can help

Being able to communicate your needs, or just to reach out to another person, is something we all value. If your ability to speak or swallow has been affected by a stroke or other illness, a Speech Language Pathologist may be able to help bring you back into the conversation.

What you can expect

If your Care Coordinator has suggested that you could benefit from speech therapy, a Speech Language Pathologist will contact you to assess your ability to speak and/or swallow. They will work with you to determine your therapy goals, develop a personalized treatment plan to increase your ability to communicate or improve your swallowing function, and monitor and assess your progress.

Your Speech Language Pathologist will teach and help counsel family members and caregivers about communication challenges you may be facing. They will also be able to suggest strategies to compensate for difficulties and help make improvements.

Your Speech Language Pathologist will also identify other resources and support services available in your community.
