With more than 4,000 local community service listings (and 50,000 province-wide), Centralhealthline.ca puts detailed, accurate information at your fingertips.



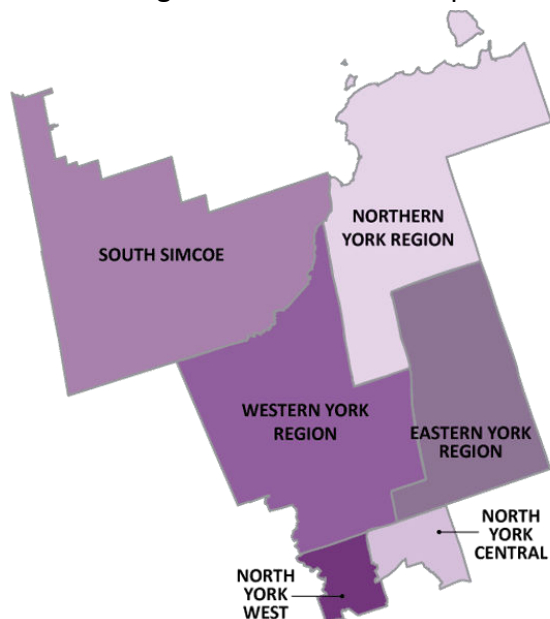
